

I am proposing an additional executive board position known as Accessibility Chair that will assist us in making our community and programming accessible to all participants. Coordinating requests for access services as well as implementing our own initiatives has proven to be a job in and of itself, and designating one person to fill that roll will ensure it is done thoroughly and completely.

The amendment itself will be under Article 4, added to the end of Section 3, and is available below.

#### Accessibility Chair

- Term Length: 1 semester
- Eligibility to Run: Active Hillel member for at least 1 semester
- Ensure Hillel events are accessible to attendees
- Coordinate access services requests

As stipulated in the RIT Hillel constitution, this amendment will be voted on at next week's executive board meeting, which will be held at 8pm on Sunday, October 18, 2020.
